Bingo Report

Attendance at bingo has picked up as of late. From April 4th through May 16th, we had 845 total players or an average of 121. Bingo receipts for that period of seven weeks was \$26,307.00. Prizes awarded amounted to \$18,900. Bingo supplies and fees for that period totaled \$1,146. Post bills paid during this time frame totaled \$4,493.38.

Our Wednesday night bingo provides a significant source of income for the Post. That is why all members who are available and able are encouraged to help out with this weekly program. We have two time frames that one can volunteer for: 5:30 to 7:30pm or 7:30 to 9:30pm. If you can spare two hours on any given Wednesday night, please just show up; we'll find a slot for you to assist. If we get enough volunteers we would like to set up "shifts" for weekly volunteering.
