Melvin Roads Wednesday night bingo has been doing very well. Attendance has been up substantially and consistently. For the first six weeks of the third quarter there have been 707 players, or an average of 118. Gross income has been \$22,068; prizes offered \$16,200 not including the two special cover-alls, leaving \$5,029 available for paying post bills. And for this quarter to date we have paid \$5,993 bills of the Post. If you add the first and second quarter to this figure, \$22,516 in bills have been paid on behalf of the Post.
