We had quite a few events take place since the last newsletter and I am here to let you know all were a success. As I stated, we need more people to volunteer to help run these events so that the responsibility of making them happen doesn't fall on the same individuals because that is the case now.

That being said, I regret to have to take this time and space to seriously point out that the Post is barely getting by and keeping our doors open is becoming more of a challenge. Some will say "we're holding our own" and in fact that is painfully true!

There are some factors that you need to know. Bingo has become our biggest source of income and we are on the brink of shutting bingo down due to the lack of volunteers to work on

Wednesday nights. We need more help in assisting the chairman, selling tickets, selling pull tabs, callers and folks working the floor. This is what is needed in personnel each week: 2 persons to handle the paperwork and banking and deposit; from 5:15 to 7:45 10 persons to cover all posts; 7:15 to 10pm, 5 persons to run the games. We really need three callers to be able to always have someone available to fill that important task. And we must do all this in compliance with the gaming laws: all these persons must belong to either the Post, Auxiliary or the SONS or Riders to work bingo.

I am calling on all Melvin Roads members to please contact us and let us know that you can offer your assistance even if it is only one Wednesday a month. I have met with the President of the Board and we have discussed alternatives if bingo has to be cancelled. Legionnaires, those alternatives are not pretty. As a member of this Post who has sat on the Board and held the position of Adjutant when we were


Melvin Roads Ladies Auxiliary...

Bingo Report

Bob Doherty, Bingo Chair, at the January meeting of the Post presented the final financial figures for Bingo for the vear ended December 31. 2016. In all there were 5.946 players at the 50 Wednesday night Bingo's held in 2016. Added to an opening balance of \$1,412, total receipts were \$173,686 and from that amount \$134,200 went toward prizes. Bingo equipment, licensing and other fees added up to \$6,990 which left a net profit of \$32,495 for the year. Of that amount, \$33,223 in Post bills were paid from the bingo profits just last year. A closing balance of \$930 was recorded.

It has been said so many times but again, *our Post would not survive without bingo*. We need volunteers. Come and give us a hand any Wednesday!

The Paul Donnelly Scholarship

Melvin Roads Post annually offers a \$500 scholarship to prospective high school graduates. Applicants must be in their second semester of their senior year of high school and a child or grandchild of an active member [dues are paid up through the award year] of Melvin Roads American Legion Post 1231, the Auxiliary or Squadron. Applicants must either have been accepted at an accredited two or four year institution of higher learning, or have formally applied to such an institution. If an acceptance letter has not been received by the submission date of the application, then such an acceptance letter must be in the hands of the committee before an award is made. A check in the amount of \$500 will be prepared on or before August 1st of the award year and will be payable in the name of the institution of higher learning and the name of the recipient. The scholarship committee will review the applications submitted and determine the awardee. A completed application must be mailed to Melvin Roads Post 1231, 200 Columbia Turnpike, Rensselaer, NY 12144 by midnight May 31st of the award year. Applications are available at the Post.
