Commander's Message

Hello Legion Family,

I hope this newsletter finds everyone well. With the weather getting colder, we are entering a very busy time of year with Veterans Day just around the corner and New Year's Eve in just a couple months. Please take a look at all the activities in the newsletter and join us for as many of the upcoming events that you can.

Since being Commander, many have worked diligently to improve out Post. Now, we see that it's not just a money issue. We have over 380 post members, plus another couple hundred in the Auxiliary and Son's, but yet we still see the same faces at meetings and events. Those numbers are starting to dwindle because these same members are getting burned out from all that they are putting into your Post.

We have had to lower the quorum for the Post meetings, and still we have a difficult time meeting that quorum. We have several openings for Post and Board positions that we were not able to fill because of lack of participation. Most importantly, the Post is in need of a Bingo chair (or two to split the workload). Bingo pays the majority of the Post's expenses and bills, if a Bingo chair is not found in the near future we will have to cancel Bingo. I'm not going to imply that we will be closing our Post, but there is a real threat of that happening without volunteers. The Post needs its members to participate at meetings, and at events (regardless of which entity is hosting it). Money alone will not keep the Post open, we need volunteers now.

Beginning January 2016, The National American Legion will be increasing the Post portion of the dues by \$5. The Department of New York will be covering \$2 of that increase, so at the last Post meeting, an increase of 43 to begin January 2016 was passed. To avoid increase for your 2015 Post Dues, please have it in before Decembers 31st.

Pearl Harbor Remembered At Melvin Roads Post December 7th

The attack on Pearl Harbor December 7, 1941 is ever etched on the minds of those who are old enough to remember. For the rest, it is our solemn duty as members of the American Legion to bring this horrific day to the attention of those younger and who may not appreciate the meaning of this solemn occasion. At 12 noon, Monday, December 7th, 2015 Melvin Roads Post will hold a moment of prayer and remembrance for veterans and the wider community. This day commemorates the attack on Pearl Harbor, Hawaii by the Imperial Japanese Navy. This surprise attack led President Roosevelt to say that "this is a day that will go down in infamy." It signaled the entry of the US in WWII.
