**15th Anniversary September 11th Ceremonies Set**

September 11th, 2016 has been designated by our President as a National Day of Service and Remembrance—Patriot Day. Melvin Roads Post 1231 will honor the memories of those who died 15 years ago with ceremonies at the Post beginning at 12Noon that Sunday.
