Paul Donnelly Scholarship

Children or grandchildren of a member of the Melvin Roads Post family are invited to apply for the \$1,000 Paul Donnelly Scholarship which is offered annually. Applicants must be in their Senior year of high school and have applied to or have been accepted at an accredited two or four year-college. \$500 is awarded c. August 1st and the second \$500

prior to enrollment in the second semester. Application forms may be obtained at the Post; they have also been made available to the Guidance Office at Columbia and other local high schools. Deadline is March 1st.

This day commemorates the attack on Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, Sunday Morning, December 7th, 1941 by the Imperial Japanese Navy. This surprise attack led President Roosevelt to say that

2,345 US military died along with 57 civilians; 1,247 more military were wounded. 4 battleships were sunk, 4 more damaged, 2 destroyers sunk, one other damaged.

Prayers are requested for our beloved dead who made the supreme sacrifice 70 years ago.
